- Field Days
- Field Trip "of sorts". Looking into Spirit of Boston or Odyssey boat cruise for either day or evening. Ideally would want to rent out the entire boat for the WMS 8th grade class only. Expensive, could be in the $\$ 3500$ 's. Need staff chaperones ( $10: 1$ ratio needed for any type of field trip), parent chaperones. Nothing is finalized.
- Moving forward ceremony on the common for 8th grade class; 258 students. Permits need to be worked out. Need to contact Baystate rental for chairs/ ? tent. Will contact WCTV to televise. Ceremony would be approx. 1 hour in the evening. Dr. Quirk/Dr. Faircloth/Dr. Brand would say a few words, Team awards would be given out, students would get a blank certificate and complete one would be sent home along with report cards. Dr. Quirk would like to have a photographer take pics of each student receiving his/her certificate to include in the package that gets sent home. She will have a backup plan in case the ceremony is canceled due to severe weather. SignUp genius for donations such as decorations, volunteers, etc. It would be nice to start a tradition where the 7th grade parents help out with the 8th grade ceremony.

g. Shannon G. recommended the PAC end this year with $\$ 3000$ balance on the books to cover the bare minimum next year.
h. Plan well in advance.
i. Let parents know what the donated money will be used for.
