# Principal's Report: Dr. Quirk (interim principal)

- Girl Scout Project proposal (feminine product machines) presented by Katherine Murphy at the January meeting does not need formal approval due to cost. Katherine Murphy will give her presentation at the School Committee Meeting March 10th. PAC will write a check for \$500 made out to the Roman House to cover the cost of two dispensers.
- Dr. Quirk loves the idea of having yard signs to celebrate students moving up to the next grade. The "ultimate goal" is to have them for the 8th grade but would really like for all grades to be recognized. She is concerned about gatherings and maintaining social distancing. Ideally she would like to have separate dates for each class. Dr. Quirk to look into dates including rain date; ? the last 3 Wednesdays of the school year. She would like Cohort C (remote students) to participate also. Need to determine a time that will accommodate students and families. Maybe signs could be placed in the West parking lot and have a drive through where people can get out of their cars briefly and take pictures in front of the signs; make sure West staff have left for the day so that lot is clear. This was similar to last year which was successful. Alternatively, signs could be placed at the WMS on the grassy corner by the Challenger door. Signs cannot be placed on the fields as they will be used for sports. Dr. Quirk is requesting help with brainstorming specifics. Jen Jackson will contact Chenelle Romano of North Shore Yard Signs about renting signs for a couple of days and if she has had experience orchestrating a similar event. Dr. Quirk will have T-shirts made up for the 8th grade class also.
- Dr. Quirk is packing up art supplies for remote students and is requesting assistance to deliver them at the end of the week. (approx. 102). Jen Jackson and Lisa D'Anna to help with deliveries. Heather Long will post need for parent volunteers as well.
